Club Sports Coordinator Ben White Visits Senate

Ben White, the new Club Sports Coordinator, recently visited the Senate to explain the Club Sports program. This agreement allows club sports teams the guidance and funding necessary to compete on the NCAA level without having to become varsity sports teams.

The Club Sports Agreement is the culmination of two years of negotiations among Athletics, the Student Union, and the administration of Brandeis University. Under it, club sport teams will be able to use the facilities and the resources that the Department of Athletics has while also receiving funds pooled together through by the Student Activities Fee. In short, this agreement basically doubles the amount of money available to the club sports teams so that they can afford the equipment, facilities, and coaching that they need.

Currently, White is working on creating the Club Sports Advisory Committee. One of their responsibilities will involve the distribution of Student Activities Fee money among the many different club sports teams.

Ideally, the new Club Sports program will be sustainable and all parties involved will be satisfied. This is the first full year of the new Club Sports Program's implementation and we expect good things to come in the future.
